



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By registering your child for Spotlight Fine Arts Camp, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Registration & Payment: A non-refundable deposit is required to hold your camper's spot. Full payment is due on the Friday prior to the start of your selected camp week. Failure to pay in full by the deadline may result in loss of your camper's spot and discounts. Discounts cannot be combined with. Scholarships are applied to the full tuition rate. Registration is non-transferable.

2. Refund Policy: Tuition refunds are 50% of the total paid, excluding the deposit. Refunds are only issued for documented illness or a death in the immediate family. In these cases, tuition may also be transferred to a future camp week (subject to availability). No refunds or credits are given for missed days, early departures, or late arrivals.

3. Behavior & Conduct: At Spotlight, we are committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive environment for every child, staff member, volunteer, and family. We maintain a zero-tolerance policy for verbal abuse, harassment, bullying, intimidation, or threatening behavior of any kind. Any individual who engages in disrespectful, abusive, or harassing conduct toward campers, staff, volunteers or others may be subject to immediate removal from camp activities and/or termination of participation privileges. We expect all members of our camp community to communicate with kindness, respect, and professionalism at all times.

4. Health & Safety: Parents/guardians must disclose all allergies, medical needs, or behavioral concerns on the registration forms. In case of illness, please keep your child home. Spotlight Fine Arts Camp reserves the right to send home any camper who appears ill. Staff will do a temperature check and notify parents of findings. If needed, the camper will be temporarily removed from the respective camp session and wait with a member of our camp's team.

5. Schedule & Curriculum: Our camp provides a well-rounded, inclusive, arts-centered program designed to expose campers to a variety of artistic mediums and creative experiences. Camp activities, instruction, group placements, and schedules are subject to change at the discretion of camp staff based on camper interest, skill level, participation, enrollment, staffing, facility availability, age group, weather and overall program needs.

By signing or submitting your registration, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to abide by these terms and conditions.



REFUND POLICY

Spotlight Fine Arts Camp understands there are situations that may prevent you from moving forward with your registration. Our aim is to support you should this be the case. Please review our refund and cancellation policy listed below.

A \$25 deposit will be due within 72 hours of registering for a camp. This deposit is non-refundable. If the deposit is not received within this 72 hour period, the spot held in that camp will be released until which point the deposit is received. Returning campers are exempt from this deposit.

The full tuition is due at 5 pm the Friday prior to the start of the chosen camp. If payment is not received by this deadline, the student will be withdrawn from the camp and may not return unless tuition is paid in full and space remains available.

In cases of a camper's illness or an illness or death in the immediate family, we are able to present two options:

- a. a refund of up to 60% percent of the amount paid
- b. an application of the tuition to a camp in a different week

Please note that refunds will not be granted for missed days or early withdrawal for non-emergency reasons.

The \$25 deposit remains non-refundable in all cases.



DISCIPLINE AND BEHAVIOR POLICY

We're committed to creating a safe, supportive, and fun space where all campers can grow artistically and socially. To ensure that every child has a positive experience, we ask families to review and support the following behavior policy:

ZERO TOLERANCE RULES

These actions result in immediate dismissal:

- Bringing any form of weapon
- Physical fighting, threats, or acts of violence
- Bringing any illegal substance or paraphernalia
- Verbal attacks on staff or volunteers

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

All campers are expected to:

- Be respectful to staff and fellow campers
- Follow directions and participate safely
- Use kind language and keep hands to themselves
- Take care of camp materials and spaces

BEHAVIOR SUPPORT & CONSEQUENCES

We believe in guiding behavior through communication and clear steps:

1. **Verbal Reminder:** Camp staff will redirect the camper with a clear, kind explanation.
2. **Private Conversation:** If the behavior continues, the camper will meet with staff for a one-on-one discussion.
3. **Parent Contact:** We will call or speak with a parent/guardian to share concerns and partner on a plan.
4. **Written Behavior Notice:** Families will receive written documentation, and the camper may be placed on a behavior plan.
5. **Suspension** (1–2 days): If serious behavior persists, the camper may be asked to stay home to reflect and reset.
6. **Dismissal from Camp:** Repeated or severe behavior issues may lead to removal from the program.

COVID-19 AND FLU SAFETY POLICY

At Spotlight Fine Arts Camp, the health and safety of our students, staff, and families is a top priority. To help prevent the spread of illness and keep our camp community healthy, we ask all participants to follow the guidelines below:

If Your Camper is Sick:

- Campers must stay home if they are experiencing fever, cough, sore throat, chills, vomiting, diarrhea, or fatigue.
- If a camper tests positive for COVID-19 or flu, they must stay home for at least 5 days and may return only when symptoms are improving and they've been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.
- If your camper's symptoms do not improve within the camp week, the registration fee can be applied toward any age-appropriate camp offerings the following week, or to any subsequent age-appropriate Toombstone Productions camps. If unable to attend succeeding camp weeks, or if your camper was registered for the final week of camp, a refund of 50% of the registration fee will be applied;

Exposure to COVID-19 or Flu:

- If your camper is exposed but not showing symptoms, they may attend camp with a mask for 5 days and should monitor for symptoms.
- If symptoms develop, please keep them home and consult a healthcare provider.

While at Camp:

- We encourage regular hand washing and hand sanitizer use.
- Camp spaces and shared materials are cleaned regularly.
- Staff will monitor campers for signs of illness and contact families if needed.

Masks:

- Masks are optional unless otherwise noted due to exposure or public health updates.
- We support any camper who chooses to wear a mask for their comfort and safety.

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

Cell Phones:

- If a camper must bring a phone, it must remain on silent or vibrate and stored in a clear, labeled zip-lock bag.
- Phones may only be used during designated break times with staff permission.
- Phones will not be allowed in workshops, rehearsals, or performances.

Gaming Devices, Tablets, iPads, and Laptops:

- These devices are not permitted at camp.
